First Baptist Church Maryville (FBCM) Deacon Nominations - 2023

Who comes to mind when you think of "servant leaders" within our church body?

FBCM deacons are chosen and ordained by the church to be servant leaders and ministers to the congregation. They serve in vital servant-ministries and provide service-oriented leadership. Deacons assist the pastors by providing care for the church's members and other persons in the community.

Our church maintains a rotating deacon membership with active deacons serving for three years and then rotating off for at least one year. For 2023 there are currently 20 active Deacons with 8 of these rolling off at the end of the year.

Nominees must have been FBCM members for at least one (1) year as of August 1, 2023. For other deacon qualifications and responsibilities, see the Deacons document approved by the Deacon Body June 28, 2018 and available on fbcmaryville.org.

After <u>prayerful consideration</u>, please complete the form below to nominate individuals you consider gifted and qualified to serve as deacons. You may submit names of persons to be considered for deacon service either as a new deacon or an inactive deacon returning to active service. It is NOT necessary to have contacted your nominees. Inactive deacons must be nominated and affirmed to return to active service. Those elected this year will serve a three-year term January 2024 through December 2026.

Active deacons NOT eligible for nomination this year are listed on the back of this page.

Place this nomination form in the offering plate/kiosk or in the box located in the hall outside the church office. Nominations are NOT valid if the form is not signed.
