ONLINE DIRECTORY FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I get the directory on my phone?

During the week after joining FBCM, the office assistants send new members a login and temporary password to use in accessing this program. If you don't remember receiving it or lost it, please contact the office and ask for a new one and confirm your email address, so we can send you a new one. Then go to the App Store or Google Play to download the ShelbyNext Membership App. Once you login, you can change your password at the option on the bottom of the page of the edit screen.

What is the domain name the app asks for when I log into the app on my phone?

The domain name should read the following: <u>fbcmaryville.shelbynextchms.com</u>. This is also the web address you use to access our directory online.

How do I update my information on the app?

Click on your picture or circle on the bottom of the home page. Then press "Edit" on bottom left of the next page. Make your changes and "Save" in top right corner. The information will be sent to the office for approval as a safety measure. It will then update once approved.

How do I add or update my profile picture on my app?

Click on your picture (or the circle on the bottom where picture would be) of the home page. Then press "Edit" on bottom left of the next page. Click on your photo, and on the next page, click on the word "Edit" at the bottom of the screen. The app will then prompt you to choose a photo from your phone or take a selfie to put on your page.

Why does my app only show a portion of the directory or just people I interact with and not the full directory?

Click on "Individuals," and look at the top of the next page (where the names are listed) and see if it says "Individuals" or "Directory." To see the entire directory, it needs to be set on "Directory" via toggle switch at the end of that line.


