Hello!

I am excited to be at First Baptist Maryville on January 29, to lead worship. As an introduction, let me tell you about myself and my family.

I grew up in a Christian home as a member of First Baptist Church in Murray, Kentucky. God spoke to me when I was fourteen to convict me of my sin and my need of Him. I accepted Him as my Savior then and still strive to follow Him daily.

I met my wife, Rita, while attending a Southern Baptist Church in Madison, Wisconsin. At the time, I was working on my Master's Degree and she was a biomedical engineer. Rita was born in Kingsport, TN, grew up in Conyers, GA, and graduated from Emory and Georgia Tech before moving to Madison.

Rita and I married in 1989 and moved to Cincinnati where I attended the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music to pursue a DMA in Piano Performance and Rita taught math and computer science at the College of Mount St. Joseph. Outside of church, Rita and I have enjoyed raising service puppies for Canine Companions for Independence, and we led the Smoky Mountain Chapter of CISV (a global peace organization that provides camps for children and youth) as Co-Presidents for three years. We both like working in our garden.

I love God, love working with choirs and musicians, and love crafting and leading worship services. I feel God calls me to develop meaningful worship experiences that help draw people closer to Him and to each other. I enjoy creating opportunities for people to use their gifts and abilities within the body of Christ.


- Consign your best items as a consignor. You may sign up for \$10 in the church office.
