


The Caregiver Cafe' will meet on Thursdays, May 12 and 26, at 9am, in the FLC Snack Room. Facilitated by Lori Bishop.

MISSION OPPORTUNITIES

EXTREME BUILD MISSION TRIP JUNE 12-17

We are looking for individuals with or without skill who want to live into our CORE value, "We love others through acts of service." We will partner with a local mission in Whitley City, KY, to work on a house doing everything from siding, flooring, painting, and finish work. Our goal is to have the house ready to be dedicated to a selected family who otherwise would not have a chance at home ownership.

There are three options for participation. (1) Stay the whole week for \$300 which includes food, transportation, lodging (double occupancy), and loads of fun. (2) Secure and fund your own transportation and lodging at a nearby campsite or hotel and pay \$25 a day. (3) Drive up for one or more days and sleep in your own bed each night and pay \$25 a day.
